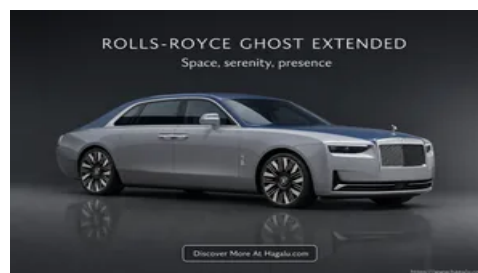

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01 Overview & Quick Facts

Ghost Extended is listed separately from standard Ghost in the Rolls-Royce Motor Cars Johannesburg range because it serves a more rear-focused owner. The extended format provides a stronger chauffeur-led proposition while retaining the cleaner and less ceremonial identity of Ghost. It is an alternative to Phantom Extended rather than a simple step below it: buyers may prefer Ghost's contemporary restraint but still need more rear accommodation than the standard body supplies. The case for the model should begin with passenger habits. If the owner regularly works, reads, rests or holds conversations in the rear during long journeys, the extended cabin can return value every day. If rear seats are used only occasionally, the standard Ghost may be easier to park and more natural to drive. A lengthened luxury saloon bought mainly for hierarchy can become an avoidable burden in tight basements and residential garages. The additional room earns its place only when it supports a real routine. Commissioning requires equal attention to the rear and front environments. Rear colours should remain restful over time, materials should tolerate repeated entry and...

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Expert Verdict

"Ghost Extended is the right Ghost when rear passengers use the extra accommodation often enough to justify the larger footprint."

Ghost Extended succeeds when it is commissioned around a genuine chauffeur-led routine. It offers more rear emphasis than standard Ghost without adopting the full ceremony of Phantom Extended, which gives it a distinctive place in the range. The additional scale is not universally beneficial: owner-drivers and people using tight garages may be happier in standard Ghost. Buyers should measure access, define rear-cabin activities and obtain a complete written quotation before choosing materials. With those foundations, Ghost Extended provides a composed mobile workspace or retreat. Without them, its extra length risks becoming a symbol that delivers less practical value than the standard car.

City Driving	Ghost Extended is effective in a structured city routine with known collection points, reserved parking and a chauffeur familiar with each destination. Its rear cabin can preserve privacy between meetings and reduce the disruption of a busy schedule. The practical risk lies in access: narrow basement turns, short hotel bays and crowded school entrances can make the additional length noticeable. Buyers should measure home and work parking and rehearse difficult routes. A calm exterior specification may also suit professional use better than a highly conspicuous one. Good planning allows the passenger benefit to remain central rather than being overshadowed by manoeuvring.
Highway	Intercity travel is one of the strongest reasons to choose Ghost Extended. The added rear accommodation is useful when passengers spend hours reading, working or resting, and the cabin can be commissioned around those activities. Long-distance buyers should think about seat support, interior glare, luggage, connectivity needs and the availability of suitable tyres away from major centres. A darker or more restrained cabin may remain comfortable across repeated journeys. The chauffeur should know secure stopping points and roadside procedures. When the owner uses the rear consistently, the extended format can turn travel time into productive or restorative time.
Off-Road	Ghost Extended is a road saloon and should not be used as an alternative to Cullinan for remote or deeply broken routes. Its long body makes driveway crests, steep ramps and sudden surface changes particularly important. Buyers who travel to estates, lodges or rural properties should inspect the complete approach rather than only the final parking area. Well-maintained gravel can be approached carefully, but repeated ruts, loose tracks and narrow gates undermine the car's intended role. Wheel selection should reflect normal surfaces. Where rough access is unavoidable, a high-riding model will protect the ownership experience more convincingly.

Best For

The model suits executives, principals, professionals and families who are regularly chauffeured but prefer Ghost's understated character to Phantom's formality. It is appropriate when rear passengers use travel time for work or recovery and when the car visits buildings able to accommodate a long saloon. The ideal owner has secure parking, a consistent driver or chauffeur and a clear view of how the rear cabin will be used. Buyers who mainly drive themselves or frequently visit constrained properties should compare standard Ghost before deciding that extra length is necessary.
